
Grandview School Sets Fundraising Record of \$26,379 for St. Jude Children's Research Hospital

Board of Education Engages in Long-Range Facility Planning

At recent meetings, the Board of Education has discussed the long-term capital requirements of our schools in light of aging buildings and potential demographic changes within our community. Consideration is being given to the possibility of major capital projects, including possible expansion of both schools. The Board, in cooperation with our architectural firm, is in the process of compiling and reviewing a list of its long-term needs.

The Board also recently updated its demographic study to reflect the increase in the number of homes in the Borough. A copy of the presentation to the Board on the results of that update can be found [here](#).

As we advance through the planning process, the Board will engage the community through a number of mechanisms to obtain feedback and opinions on the options available to the community. Any major expansion would be presented in a referendum, which requires a ballot vote through the election process.
