NCBOE Expansion Survey Results

The Board has decided to move forward with pursuing a referendum on school expansion, pursuing option 3, which will expand Gould, move 3rd grade students to Gould, and provide specific renovations and upgrades to Grandview. Central air conditioning is still under consideration. This decision is in light of the academic advantages, significant cost differential, survey results, other community input, and future flexibility. Specific options will likely be determined in July 2017. The target date for the referendum vote is March 2018. Your continued input is welcome!


